FIRST AID:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

WARNING: This product is corrosive to iron, steel and aluminum if left in contact for long period of time. It is recommended that all metal pumps, lines and nozzles be flushed at the end of each day with fresh water. Use acid resistant metering pumps. Plastic parts (lines, nozzles and fittings) are strongly recommended.

Apl-Kleen® requires dilutions with water at a rate determined by the condition of the fruit. A typical rate for fairly clean apples is 1 gallon of Apl-Kleen® to 100 gallons of water. This dilution can be used in flume systems for apples or can also be sprayed onto apples and pears for 15 to 30 seconds. Follow the application by thoroughly rinsing the fruit with fresh water. For fruit that is difficult to clean, or with visible calcium deposit, use less dilution water to make a more concentrated cleaner.

Apl-Kleen® is an acid cleaner for post harvest cleaning of apples and pears.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Storage: This product should be stored in a cool, dry place. Keep container tightly closed.

Disposal: For leaks and spills, neutralize with soda ash or a mild alkali. Absorb with sand or vermiculite and dispose of neutralized materials in compliance with local regulations.

Rinse container with a dilute alkali solution, followed by a water rinse. Wash solution may be dumped in sewer with further dilution. Rinsed container may be recycled or properly disposed of.
