Deccosol[®] 122 Concentrate Decay and Mold Control 14.5% SOPP Low-foam

DESCRIPTION

A fungicidal concentrate for the control of organisms causing decay of citrus, sweet potatoes, apples and pears after harvest, and for the suppression of stem-end and surface molds on cantaloupes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For use on Citrus: Dilute 1 gallon of Deccosol 122 Concentrate with 46 to 80 gallons of water for use in citrus washing tanks at a concentration ranging from 0.2 to 0.35% sodium orthophenylphenate (anhydrous). Caustic soda should be added when necessary to maintain the pH in the washing tank above 11.6. The citrus should not be in the washing tank for more than 5 minutes and must be rinsed thoroughly with fresh water upon leaving tank. Or, for use in the Decco process by or under the supervision of Decco personnel.

COMPOSITION

The product contains 14.5% anhydrous sodium orthophenylphenate as active fungicide in a concentrated solution of EPA approved cleaners. This product is packaged in 55-gallon drums.

EPA Registration No. 2792-28.

PRECAUTIONS: This product is for agricultural use only. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.

DANGER: Causes Burns. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.

First aid: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. Call a physician. Wash clothing before reuse. Discard shoes. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Give large quantities of water. Give at least one ounce of vinegar in an equal amount of water.

Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician.

Hazards to humans and domestic animals: DANGER. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid breathing mist. Keep container closed. Wash thoroughly after handling. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Causes eye damage and skin irritation.

Environmental hazard: This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool dry place.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used according to label instructions must be

disposed of according to Federal, State, or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if permitted by State and local authorities.

Do not use after two years after the date of manufacture. Once opened use the entire contents of the container within 120 days.
