Use: Lower rates for control of green mold (*Penicillium spp*) and blue mold (*Penicillium spp.*) on citrus fruit

States: California

This is a recommendation of FIFRA Section 2(ee) as it relates to the use of lower than the current label use rates of Graduate A+ Fungicide as a postharvest dip/drench application for the control of green and blue mold of citrus fruit. The user must refer to the federally approved label for Graduate A+ and read and follow all directions for use, restrictions, and precautions.
