Component Information

Polysorbate 60 (Sorbitan monostearate, ethoxylated) Long-term administration in the feed of hamsters, mice and dogs produced no adverse effects, while rats showed diarrhea and fatty changes in the liver. Repeated dermal application to mice showed no systemic effects, but did have promoting activity for the production of skin tumors following carcinogenic application. No birth defects were noted in the offspring of rats and mice exposed orally during pregnancy, but slightly reduced pup weight was noted. No effects were seen on the ability of male or female rats to reproduce when exposed orally for three successive generations, but a decreased pup survival was noted at the highest dose level. Genetic changes were observed in a test using bacteria but, generally, no genetic changes were observed in tests using animal cells.
